



Course: Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Familiarization

Course aim

The overall aim of the LNG Familiarization Course is to provide information to the participants about specific duties and responsibilities, including characteristics of tanker cargoes, their associated hazards, safety measures, pollution prevention, emergency operation related to cargo and cargo equipment on LNG tankers.

Course objectives

On completion of the LNG Familiarization Course, the trainees are expected to be able to:

- To recognize the LNG vessels and their specific equipment.
- To perform specific duties and responsibilities related to those duties in connection with cargo and cargo equipment for LNG vessels.
- To understand the procedures of safe handling of LNG tanker cargoes and their effect on the safety of life and of the ship.
- To know the precautions to be taken on board LNG tankers to prevent pollution of the marine environment.
- To practice the safe operation of the LNG tanker cargo pumping systems in accordance with established rules and procedures.

Target group

The master, chief engineer, chief officer, second engineer, deck and engine officers, electro technical officer and ratings assigned to duties related to cargo handling and cargo equipment on board tanker, as well as take care of cargo.

Entry requirements

- Valid CoC according STCW qualification: Regulation A-V/1-2-1

Booking
