



Course: BRIDGE TEAM MANAGEMENT

Course aim

The course is an essential one in navigation because it is designed to enhance the skill and knowledge about ship handling and efficient management of the bridge team. It consists of theoretical lessons supplemented by computer, based training and ship handling simulator exercises.

Course objectives

To reduce the possibility of accidents that may lead to loss of life, damage of property or environment by enhancing navigational skills and knowledge of deck officers.

Develop and enhance officers in understanding how to handle a vessel in restricted waters and how to use available technical and human resources effectively.

The trainees are expected to be able to:

- Familiarize with the use of instrumentation and controls used on the bridge;
- Understanding and awareness of correct watchkeeping procedures;
- Experience in identifying operational problems and trouble-shooting them;
- Experience in handling ships under various conditions and will make a more effective contribution to the bridge team during ship maneuvering.
- The ability to make decisions, which promote the safety and efficiency of an operational plan.

Target group

Managerial deck officers. This course has been designed to meet the requirements of STCW section A-II/1, Table A-II/1 and is based on the guidelines of IMO Model Course 1.22.

Entry requirements

This program is open to and intended for all deck officers joining ships where Fleet Management Limited is the Manager listed in the Documents of Compliance.
