

Admission procedure for Ukrainian students in order to classify them on places financed from the state budget, as "scholarship of the Romanian government"

According to the Instructions of the Romanian Ministry of Education, in the academic year 2023/2024 Ukrainian citizens can benefit from full funding from the state budget.

Requirements:

- Be graduates of pre-university education from Ukraine in the academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023
- To present the Certificate of completion in the 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 school years (documents translated into Romanian language and legalized)
- To present the transcripts related to the years of study for higher secondary education (documents translated into Romanian language and legalized)
- In the case of maritime (technological) high school graduates, to present the Diploma and the Diploma Supplement
- Other documents: copy of passport, copy of birth certificate (legalized translation), English language proficiency Certificate, medical certificate.

Selection criteria for nomination as a scholarship holder of the Romanian government:

1. Maritime (technological) high school graduate
2. Average at the high school graduation exam, percentage of at least 60%
3. Average in Mathematics obtained in the final exam, percentage of at least 40%

Candidates who do not submit transcripts for the high school years, as well as candidates who completed their high school studies in the previous school years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023, will be able to enroll in studies and pay the tuition fees.
