

GENERAL FIRE PREVENTION RULES
IN THE ACCOMMODATION SPACES

Students and staff in the accommodation spaces have the obligation to know and respect the measures of civil protection, fire prevention and extinguishing and to participate in interventions in case of fire, according to the organization of the head of the unit (building administrator).

- Students and staff in the building are required to evacuate the building in emergency situations.
 - Students and staff in the building have the obligation to turn off all equipment and devices at the end of the work or study program, clean the workplace, dispose of all waste, disconnect all electrical equipment and devices connected with flexible cables; closing the respective rooms, and leaving the keys at the gate (if applicable);
 - During the entire period of use of the constructions, the evacuation and access routes of the intervention forces will be kept free and properly maintained, so that through them, in the event of a fire, people can reach the ground or roadway level in the shortest time and under safe conditions, directly outside or via escape stairs.
 - The access, evacuation and intervention routes are maintained in a state of use throughout the day and in any season at the parameters for which they were designed and made;
 - In the stairwells, corridors or other escape routes of the buildings, it is not allowed to set up rooms or workplaces, storage, etc. which could prevent the evacuation of people and goods, as well as the access of emergency personnel
 - It is prohibited to place cupboards, sockets, clothes dryer furniture, etc. on the escape routes (corridors), if their width is reduced below the minimum passage dimensions required according to the technical regulations;
 - It is forbidden to block or reduce in any way the dimensions of the escape routes;
 - The decommissioning of installations, devices and - in general - fire prevention and extinguishing means is prohibited. The technical means of first intervention in emergency situations are used only to act in emergency situations and not for other purposes.
 - It is forbidden to block access to the fire alarm actuation buttons, as well as to the zones of action of the detectors.
 - The preparation of food in the living rooms, the use of improvised electrical devices in the dormitory, the use of any heating source or cooking device or other combustible materials are prohibited.
 - It is forbidden to make any changes or improvisations to the electrical installation, the use of defective or improvised electrical installations, including lighting installations, sockets, electrical panels, extension cords, cables, etc.;
 - It is forbidden to overload the electrical network by using too many consumers or high power consumers;
 - Unauthorized intervention in electrical distribution panels is prohibited and also the replacement of fuses with uncalibrated improvised devices (sticks, wires).
 - Smoking in the accommodation spaces IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
 - The storage and use in accommodation spaces of: flammable substances, fuels, pyrotechnic materials, combustible materials is prohibited, regardless of their quantity and nature.
 - The use of candles or open flames is prohibited.
- Failure to comply with fire prevention and extinguishing rules constitutes a misdemeanor (if they were not committed under such conditions as to be considered crimes) and is punishable by a fine, according to the rules in force.
