

RULES FOR SELECTIVE WASTE COLLECTION



A. BLUE BIN – PAPER / CARDBOARD

Can be recycled:

- ✓ Food packaging (milk, juice, sweets, etc.);
- ✓ Paper bags;
- ✓ Boxes and other cardboard packaging;
- ✓ Waste paper (notebooks, magazines, books, envelopes, etc.).

Cannot be recycled:

- ✗ Paper and cardboard contaminated with liquids or other substances (food and industrial waste);
- ✗ Used coffee or tea cups, waxed and laminated paper, napkins and used paper towels.

B. YELLOW BIN – PLASTIC/METAL

Can be recycled:

- ✓ PETS (water, juice, beer);
- ✓ Plastic bags and packaging;
- ✓ Polystyrene waste from packaging;
- ✓ Plastic sheets;
- ✓ Containers from cosmetic, food or detergent products;
- ✓ Metal containers (boxes, etc.);
- ✓ Metal plugs;
- ✓ Aluminum cans and packaging.

Cannot be recycled:

- ✗ Plastic packaging soiled by food residues, oil or toxic substances.



C. GREEN BIN – GLASS

Can be recycled:

- ✓ Glass containers, without lids, from beverages and foodstuffs.

Cannot be recycled:

- ✗ Porcelain, ceramic and crystal objects, mirrors, classic light bulbs, neon signs, window glass, high temperature resistant glass, safety glass, etc.

D. BLACK/GRAY BIN - HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Can be recycled:

- ✓ Food scraps (cooked food, meat, eggs, dairy);
- ✓ Cigarette butts, absorbents, used tissues, the contents of the vacuum cleaner bag;
- ✓ Mirrors, windows, porcelain products.

Cannot be recycled:

- ✗ Recyclable waste;
- ✗ Textile waste, soil, sand, waste electrical and electronic equipment, batteries, tires, construction waste, waste bulky (furniture, carpets, mattresses, etc.)



It is FORBIDDEN
mixing recyclable waste with residual waste! Those who do not comply with these procedures risk fines!

How to **CORRECTLY** collect recyclable waste

COLLECT recyclable waste separately from residual waste;

EMPTY recyclable food waste packaging;

RINSES dirty plastic packaging (PETs, etc.);

REMOVE the cork before disposal;

PRESSES/FOLDS plastic/aluminum, paper/cardboard waste;

Recyclable waste that **CANNOT** be cleaned is stored in the black bin intended for residual waste. Recyclable waste that **CANNOT** be cleaned is stored in the black bin intended for residual waste.

Why is it **IMPORTANT** to collect waste separately?

- Pollution caused by the production and storage of waste is reduced;
- The consumption of non-renewable resources is reduced;
- The amount of waste deposited at the landfill is reduced;
- Recycling creates jobs;
- Energy consumption is reduced.
