

# **GRANTING PRIORITY FOR DORMITORY ACCOMMODATION**

## **I. SLM Student Dormitory**

The following categories of students are accommodated in the SLM Student Dormitory in the following order:

1. First-year students who, according to the Admission Methodology, are admitted without an entrance exam based on results obtained in national and international school olympiads;
2. Romanian students enrolled in the first year of study in tuition-free programs;
3. Students who have achieved academic performance – those who have passed all exams (integralist status) at the time of submitting the application, with an average grade of at least 8.50 in previous academic years;
4. Integralist students – regardless of the average grade obtained;
5. Students involved in volunteer activities (maximum of 5 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
6. Students who have achieved performance in extracurricular – scientific or technical – activities (maximum of 3 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
7. Performance athletes who have achieved at least national-level results (maximum of 2 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
8. Students who have achieved performance in artistic activities (maximum of 2 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
9. Students from socially and/or economically marginalized localities;
10. Students who qualify under medical criteria and do not experience mobility difficulties, as the dormitory is not equipped with an elevator and has no rooms on the ground floor;
11. Romanian and foreign students in descending order of their Baccalaureate grades/credits obtained at the time of reference.

## **II. A2 Student Dormitory**

The following categories of students are accommodated in the A2 Student Dormitory in the following order:

1. Students involved in volunteer activities;
2. First-year students who, according to the Admission Methodology, are admitted without an entrance exam based on results obtained in national and international school olympiads;
3. Students who have achieved academic performance – those who have passed all exams (integralist status) at the time of submitting the application, with an average grade of at least 8.50 in previous academic years;

4. Romanian students enrolled in the first year of study in tuition-free programs;
5. Integralist students, regardless of the average grade obtained;
6. Students who have achieved performance in extracurricular – scientific and technical – activities (maximum of 4 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
7. Students from socially marginalized localities;
8. Performance athletes who have achieved at least national-level results (maximum of 4 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
9. Students who have achieved performance in artistic activities (maximum of 4 students, selection is based on the number of credits obtained in the current year at the time of reference);
10. Students who qualify under medical criteria;
11. Romanian and foreign students in descending order of their Baccalaureate grades/credits obtained at the time of reference.

### **III. Far3 Student Dormitory**

The following categories of students are accommodated in the Far3 Student Dormitory in the following order:

1. Foreign students with Romanian government scholarships and Romanian students from abroad;
2. Students who are orphans of both parents and students from foster care/social assistance centers;
3. Students who are orphans of one parent and students from single-parent families, enrolled in tuition-free (state-funded) study programs;
4. Students whose parents are currently employed in the education system or are retired from it with at least 10 years of service in education, enrolled in tuition-free (state-funded) study programs;
5. Students who qualify under medical criteria;
6. First-year students who, according to the Admission Methodology, are admitted without an entrance exam based on results obtained in national and international school olympiads;
7. Romanian students enrolled in the first year of study in tuition-free programs;
8. Students who have achieved academic performance – those who have passed all exams (integralist status) at the time of submitting the application, with an average grade of at least 8.50 in previous academic years;
9. Students whose families have not earned, in the 12 consecutive months prior to submitting the application, a monthly net income per family member higher than the national net minimum wage;
10. Students involved in volunteer activities;

11. Students who are orphans of one parent and students from single-parent families, enrolled in tuition-based programs;
12. Students from socially marginalized localities;
13. Students whose parents are currently employed in the education system or are retired from it with at least 10 years of service in education, enrolled in tuition-based programs;
14. Students who have achieved performance in extracurricular – scientific and technical – activities;
15. Performance athletes who have achieved at least national-level results;
16. Students who have achieved performance in artistic activities;
17. Romanian and foreign students in descending order of their Baccalaureate grades/credits obtained at the time of reference.
