Candidates to doctoral studies should submit an electronic file at the above email address with the following compulsory documents:

- Application form https://cmu-edu.eu/en/wp-content/uploads/sites/7/2026/02/CPV_Application-form.pdf
- Birth certificate
- Passport
- Baccalaureate diploma, Bachelor's diploma and Master's Diploma and Diploma Supplements
- Master's degree Certificates and Transcripts of Records for current academic year graduates
- English Language Proficiency Certificate
- Statement of a doctoral advisor expressing the agreement upon a research theme for the Doctoral Degree and a recommendation for a free-tuition position in Doctoral studies
- Medical certificate
- Temporary protection residence permit (if any)

Notes:

All documents should be submitted in copies and legalized translations in Romanian, English or French

All documents should bear the Apostille/ authentication of the authorities in charge in the issuing country
