

Submission Guideline for Speakers

All speakers' abstracts will be published in the WMETMC Abstract Book titled "Highlights of WMETMC: Collection of Speakers' Presentations."

1. The organizers of WMETMC2026 invite submissions of abstracts that align with the themes of the congress. Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by experts, and those that are relevant and of high quality will be scheduled for either oral or poster presentations during the congress. Abstracts that are irrelevant or of poor quality may be rejected.
2. Abstracts can be submitted by email office.wmetmc@cmu-edu.eu. It is advisable to prepare the complete abstract text and any figures/tables before abstract submission.
3. Abstracts should be written in clear English, following these specifications:
 - The maximum word count for the abstract title is 20 words.
 - The maximum word count for the abstract text is 300 words (please adjust this if you include tables or figures)
 - Abstracts will be published exactly as submitted. No editing of abstract texts will be done. However, non-adherence to the above guidelines may be corrected by the WMETMC organizers.
4. Once an abstract has been submitted, authors cannot make any changes. If minor edits are required after submission, the author of submitting must email the WMETMC Secretariat, clearly detailing the specific change needed. The WMETMC organizers will then make the adjustment. For major changes, authors should submit a revised abstract as a completely new entry and request that the WMETMC Secretariat delete the original abstract. Please note that adding a co-author is considered a major change.
5. After completion of the abstract review, the submitting author will receive scheduling information via email. Please note that abstracts cannot be withdrawn after the submitting author has received this scheduling information. Additionally, the presenting author must be registered as a participant of WMETMC2026 for the final scheduling and publication of the abstract.
6. Accepted abstracts will be published in the WMETMC Abstract BOOK: Highlights of WMETMC -Collection of Speakers Presentations. The authors of the submitted abstracts will take responsibility of any Intellectual Property issues about the abstracts on their own. The organizing committee of WMETMC2026 has the legal rights to use the submitted abstracts for congress purposes.
